Founded in 1997, it was set up by the employees of Fairview Wine and Cheese Estate. There are 42 families who are today the team behind the scenes of the Fairvalley Association.

The Association's main objective is to address the need for sustainable housing; create jobs' and business opportunities for the members; to empower them to own their own homes under free-hold, as ownership of houses by members should not be linked to their employment. They should be allowed to create wealth for themselves if they so wish. They should be able to make the homes and the entire property value available to their families, heirs and/or successors in title.

The Fairvalley Urban Village: The development framework allows for approximately 450 residential units and 20,000 square meters of commercial and light industries to be built on the land. The intention is to use alternative eco-friendly building materials: grey water systems, solar energy and other energy efficient techniques will be used for the purposes of reduced and more sustainable energy consumption.

Fairvalley wines: The profits from the sale of the wines go directly towards developing homes on the Fairvalley Farm. The logo of the hands symbolizes the need to work, with the earth symbol etched on one hand and the water symbol etched on the other.

CHENIN BLANC

PINOTAGE
